11th June, 18th June, 25th June and 2nd July.

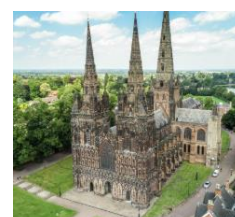


YEAR 4 LICHFIELD CATHEDRAL TRIP
