Henri Rousseau was a famous French painter. He was born in 1844 in Western France.

At school Henri won lots of prizes for drawing.

He is best known for his jungle scenes, such as a **Tiger in Tropical storm (surprised!)**.



Rousseau did not visit the jungle to see the animals, instead he visited the greenhouses in Paris at the Botanical gardens to copy plants.

How do I produce art like Rousseau?

Step 1: Take a pencil and lightly draw the objects in your landscape, e.g. trees, bushes, the horizon and the animals.

Step 2: think carefully about the colours you would like to use— clear blue sky, green for the trees?




A child's Rousseau style painting


Step 4: Draw the animal. Think carefully about which areas are lighter and darker to reflect the light and movement of the animals on your picture.

Step 3– Use different shades and tones to create texture for example when painting or drawing leaves on


